Honors Congress' Knight-Thon Committee is run by Biomedical Sciences student Breanne Peters. Knight-Thon is UCF's version of Dance Marathon.

"Our purpose is to raise money for Orlando Health's Arnold Palmer Hospital for Children," Breanne said.

This philanthropic effort is entirely student-run. Many on-campus organizations contribute to its fundraising efforts each year. Knight-Thon is a very impactful event. Breanne knew from the beginning that she wanted to get involved with Knight-Thon because it is a great cause.

"Not only is it such a fun and enjoyable event to be a part of, but we're also raising money and awareness for a very important cause and helping our community."

Over the years, UCF's Knight-Thon has donated over \$8 million to bettering our hospital systems, and Honors Congress is grateful to be a part of it.

But what role does Honnors
Congress play in such a widespread
fundraiser? According to Breanne,
HonCon raised over \$3,000 for the cause
just last year alone. Her committee's
specific purpose within both Honors
Congress is both to host fun events for
members AND to spread awareness for
a cause in need of contribution.

The Knight-Thon Committee hosts events each semester. So far this Spring,

some of their favorite events have been their craft night where members got to connect with one another while painting mini canvases. Breanne also speaks fondly of their partial proceeds event, where she partnered with Blaze Pizza to raise money for the Honors Congress Knight-Thon team.

On April 6th, the Knight-Thon Main Event will take place. This is the biggest day of the year for all sections of Knight-Thon. The event is 12 hours long and hosted annually in Addition Financial Arena, featuring an array of entertainment. Families that have been part of Dance Marathon's efforts get to share stories of how they have been positively impacted by the fundraising efforts.

Relay for Life

Relay for Life Committee celebrates success of main event

The Relay For Life committee's director is Alfonso Hilerio, who provided information about the committee and its role in Honors Congress.

For those who are unfamiliar, UCF hosts a Relay for Life each year to raise money for the American Cancer Society.

"It's a volunteer-led experience where many organizations throughout the US work together, each in their community, to raise money to put into cancer research," Alfonso explained.

The event is mainly student-led, and plenty of Registered Student Organizations raise money and participate in the event each year. Relay For Life is hugely impactful to those whose lives have been touched by cancer.

"My grandmother was diagnosed with cancer, and she was able to beat it. After seeing the challenges and effects that cancer brings to an individual, it has always been a topic that is very near and dear to my heart," Alfonso said. "When I saw that I could play a role in helping those with cancer,

I decided to try to get involved."
Honors Congress has played a large part in the fundraising efforts for quite a while. This year, HonCon raised over \$1,000, placing in the top 5 of all organizations at UCF. This fundraising comes from the events that are held for members.

"The mystery auction event would have to be our favorite event because people would have to [place bids] for mystery prizes. It created more suspense as the auction continued. Ultimately, when everyone popped their balloons to see what prize they got, it was fun to see how everyone reacted."








What is Your Favorite Season?








I step onto the roof of the mountainside tower and the world no longer exists:


Fade to gray on you and I centered in a cloud with rainwater pooling in our socks.


I check the map.

We spread it out on the dashboard and trace the route home.


